

Listen to the role play, then we'll practise the script, and learn the vocabulary.

We have used a very simple system to link vocabulary to parts of speech, see if you can hear and see any patterns in the text.

First, Ms Miller introduces herself. She's a Chinese teacher.

David arrives. Ms Miller welcomes him, then goes to get some tea.

Mr Wang appears, looking for Ms Miller. He meets David.

Ms Miller comes back. David and Mr Wang drink some tea.

David invites everyone to have lunch together.



Do you understand the colour coding?

Red: pronouns and proper names — I, you, me, David, Deng Green: verbs and doing words - am, are, eat, drink, go Blue: nouns and names of things - tea, food, Chinese teacher Black: adjectives and other parts of speech - good, please, OK
